Sometimes I am used to describe God.

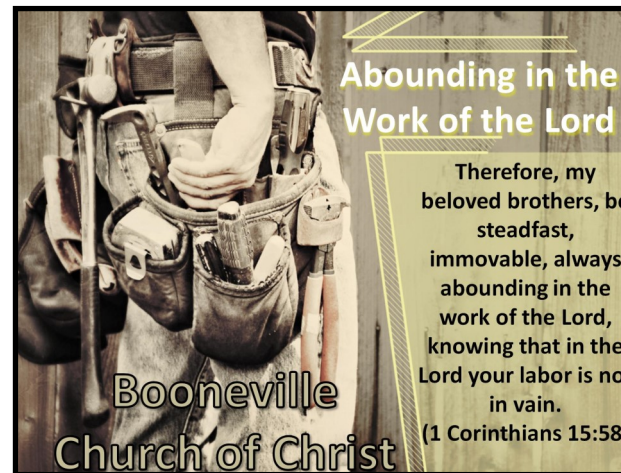
I am what prompted God to send Jesus to die for you. And I am what will prompt you to die for Jesus.
