## God's Glory Fills the Tabernacle

God told Moses to build a place where His people could worship Him. They called this place of worship the *tabernacle*. God told Moses just how it was to be built. The tabernacle was a big tent that they could fold up and take with them every time they moved their camp.

**Who told Moses how to build the tabernacle?**

Moses told the Israelites about the things God had said to use for the tabernacle. It was to be beautiful, and it was to have in it all the things needed to worship the Lord in the way He commanded. The people were so glad to give gifts to God to help build the tabernacle. They gave gold, silver, pretty cloth, animal skins, wood, and jewels. They gave until Moses had to tell them to stop. They had given *more* than was needed! Moses also asked for workers. They were happy to do the work for free.



**Can you name some of the things the Israelites gave to help build the tabernacle?**

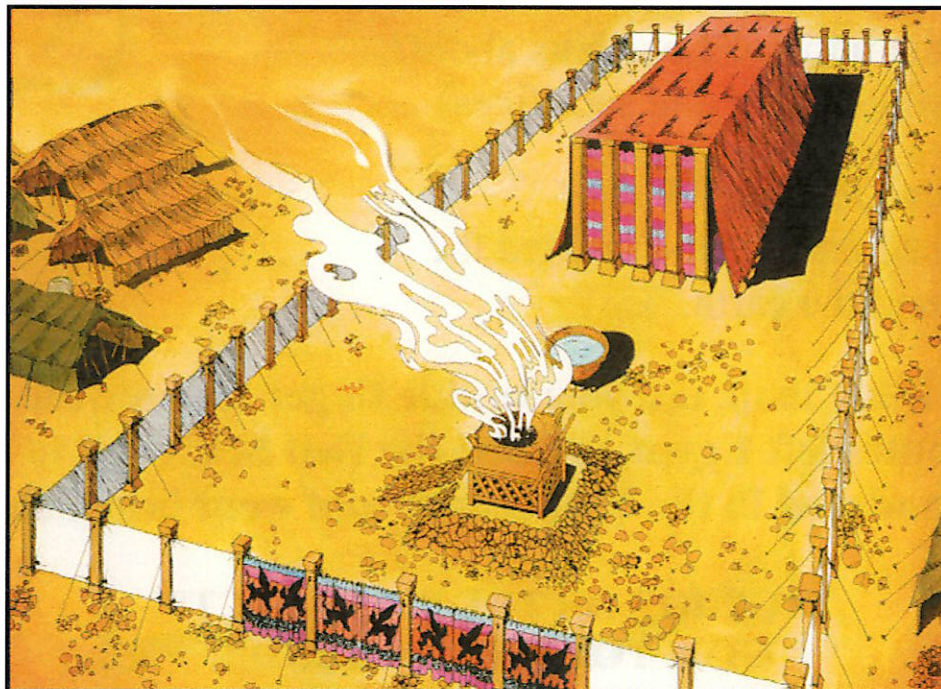
When the tabernacle was finished, Moses looked at everything carefully. The people had built it just the way God had commanded. So Moses gave the workers his blessing. God told Moses how to set the tent up and where to put everything outside and inside. At last, the tabernacle was ready! “Then the cloud covered the Tent of Meeting. The glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.” This showed that the Lord was with them.

**Circle what was *inside* the tabernacle:**

**the glory of the Lord      a bed and pillow      books**

When the people did just as the Lord commanded them, He blessed them. But when the people sinned, they had trouble. All they had to do was love and obey Him.

It’s the same for *us*. God wants us to love Him and obey His Word, so He can bless us.
