Your child should understand...

Obedience—Making good choices

6. Tell why Lot’s wife was turned into a pillar of salt.

“The Lord had said to Abram, ‘Leave your country and your people...Go to the land I will show you. I will make you into a great nation. I will bless you. I will make your name great...All nations on earth will be blessed because of you.’”

Now Lot lived in the city of Sodom. It was an evil city filled with wicked people. God told Abraham He would destroy Sodom and another evil city called Gomorrah. God would send fire and brimstone raining down on them. Abraham was worried about Lot. He asked God to let Lot escape from the city. God sent two angels to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah and to lead Lot and his family away so they would be safe.

Can you tell the class why God destroyed the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah?

The angels told Lot and his family not to look back at Sodom when the fiery rain came. But Lot's wife disobeyed. She turned and looked back at Sodom! She became a pillar of salt because she had disobeyed God. How sad it is when someone disobeys the Lord!
