


God Delivers His People from Egypt

God's people were now going to a new land they didn't know much about. They knew that God had promised them a good land. But they needed a good leader to take care of them and help them get there. God chose Moses to lead the people. By faith, Moses obeyed God.




At last, the Israelites were free from Pharaoh. They marched out of Egypt like an army. They marched through a wilderness with God watching over them. By day God led them with a pillar of cloud. By night, He led them with a pillar of fire.

When they got to the Red Sea, they looked back and saw Pharaoh's army marching, marching! Pharaoh had changed his mind. He wanted the Israelites to return to Egypt! Behind them



was *Pharaoh's army*, and in front of them was *the Red Sea*. They were trapped! But Moses told them that the Lord would save them. They were about to see again how mighty God is.

God told Moses to stretch out his hand over the Red Sea. The waters parted and were like walls on each side of a path. God made the sea floor *dry*. The people crossed on dry land without even getting muddy! God had thought of everything!



What did God do to the Red Sea so the Israelites could get to the other side? Circle one:

God put down stones for them to step on.

Then the Egyptian army tried to cross the Red Sea. God told Moses to stretch out his hand over the sea again so that the water would fall on them. The Egyptians were all drowned.
