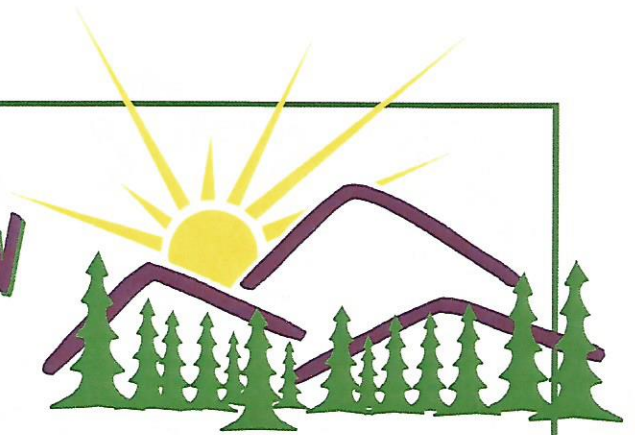

6. Tell the punishment for Adam and Eve.

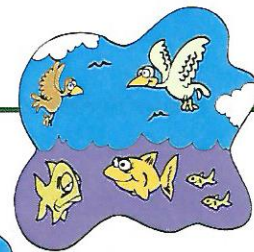
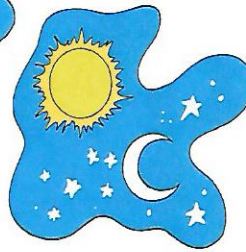
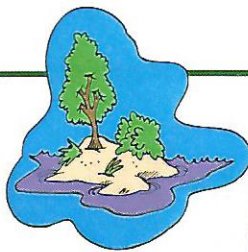
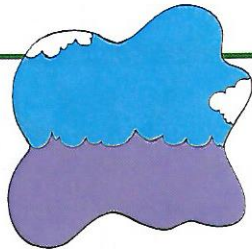
Your child should be memorizing...

God Creates the World

“In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.” God planned everything first so that it would be perfect when He finished. The world was blank and empty. But God is so powerful and good that He made and filled our world in only six days!

Who is the Creator of the world and everything in it? _____

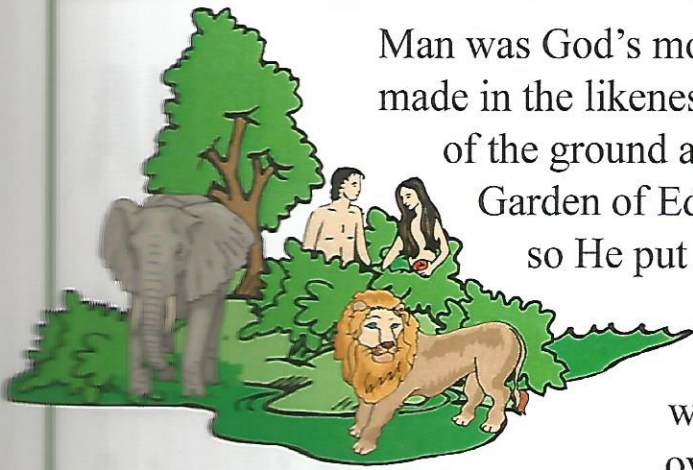
How many days did it take to create the world and everything in it? _____

On the first day, God made light and darkness. On the second day, God made the waters and the sky. The third day, God made the land and all of the growing plants. On the fourth day, God made the sun for our days and the moon and stars for our nights. On the fifth day, He made all of the fish and birds. The sixth day, God made all of the animals and man. He was pleased with His creation. God looked at everything He had made and saw that it was “very good.” On the seventh day, God rested.

Man was God's most special creation, because man was made in the likeness of God. God made Adam from the dust of the ground and put him in a beautiful garden, the Garden of Eden. But God saw that Adam was lonely, so He put Adam to sleep and took one of Adam's ribs to make a helper for him. Adam named this helper Eve. Eve was the first woman. God told Adam and Eve to rule over everything He had made.

Circle the answer. God made the woman because Adam was...

sleepy. silly. lonely.

God gave Adam and Eve all of the fruits of the garden for food except the fruit from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. God told them not to eat it! A serpent, who was really the devil, tricked Eve into taking the fruit from that tree. And, even though God had said not to, she and Adam both ate it. This was the first sin—disobeying God's commands. Because they disobeyed God, Adam and Eve had to leave the Garden of Eden forever. God told Adam that now he would have to work really hard to get food from the ground.
