



Jesus Finishes His Work Among the People

It was getting harder for Jesus to preach because so many people wanted Him to stop. But He just had to tell the people about His kingdom. Jesus told the people that He is like a shepherd to the people who love Him. A shepherd loves his sheep and takes care of them, just as Jesus takes care of the people in His kingdom. He gave His life for us!

How is Jesus like a shepherd to us?

Jesus' friends, Mary and Martha, sent a message to Jesus to tell Him that their brother Lazarus was sick. They needed Jesus to come quickly. Jesus knew how sick Lazarus was. In fact, Jesus knew that Lazarus had died. But He waited two more days to go see Mary and Martha. Jesus was about to do a miracle.



When Jesus got to Mary's and Martha's house, Lazarus had been dead for four days. Jesus was sad and cried. He stood outside the tomb and said, "Lazarus, come out!" And Lazarus came out of the tomb, all wrapped up in burial clothes! Everyone was shocked. Jesus had raised Lazarus from the dead! Jesus was truly the Son of God.
