Twelve of Jesus' followers were special. Jesus had special work for them to do. Jesus chose these twelve men to go preach about Him to the Israelites. Jesus



told these men to perform miracles, too. The miracles would prove that the men were teaching the truth about Jesus. He told them that they would be treated badly by some people. They would be beaten and yelled at, but Jesus also told them that God would take care of them and would tell them what to say.

These special men were Peter and his brother Andrew, and James and his brother John, Philip, Bartholemew, Thomas, Matthew, James (the son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus, Simon, and Judas. These were Jesus' twelve apostles.


Can you say the names of Jesus' twelve apostles without help?
