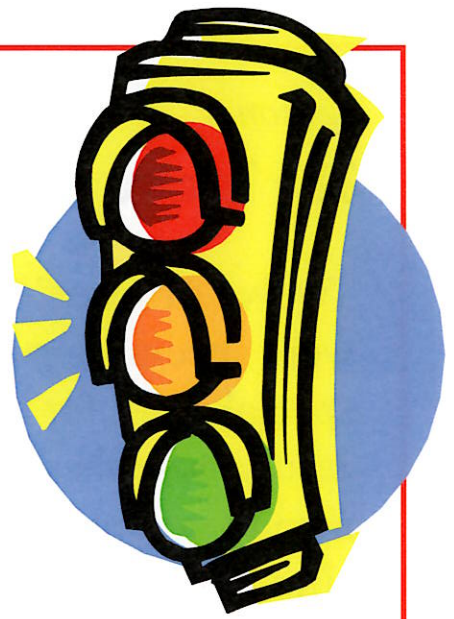

# The Twelve Apostles

Twelve of Jesus' followers were special. Jesus had special work for them to do. Jesus chose these twelve men to go preach about Him to the Israelites. Jesus told these men to perform miracles, too. The miracles would prove that the men were teaching the truth about Jesus. He told them that they would be treated badly by some people. They would be beaten and yelled at, but Jesus also told them that God would take care of them and would tell them what to say.

These special men were Peter and his brother Andrew, and James and his brother John, Philip, Bartholemew, Thomas, Matthew, James (the son of Alphaeus), Thaddaeus, Simon, and Judas. These were Jesus' *twelve apostles*.

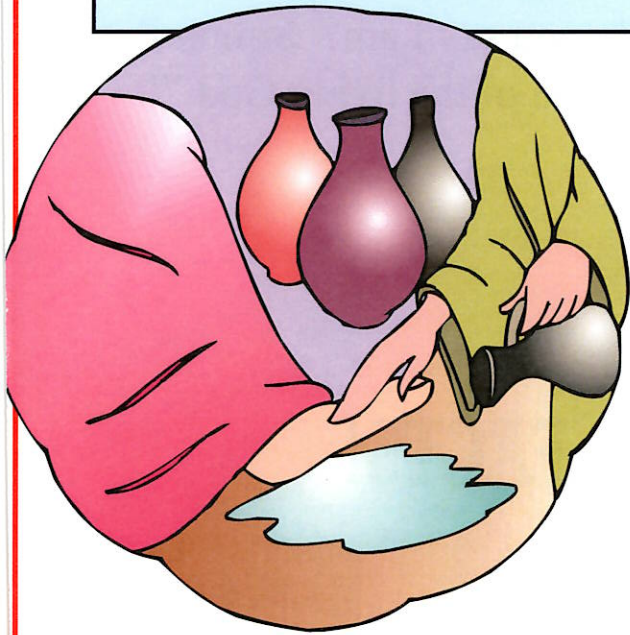
**How did Jesus say some people would treat His apostles?**

While Jesus was teaching the people and performing miracles, His cousin John was thrown into prison for preaching about Jesus. One day John sent his friends to Jesus to ask Him if He was really the Son of God. Was Jesus really the one who had been sent to save all people from their sins? Jesus told John's friends to go back to John and ask



him if he remembered all of the miracles Jesus had performed. These miracles proved that Jesus really is God's Son.

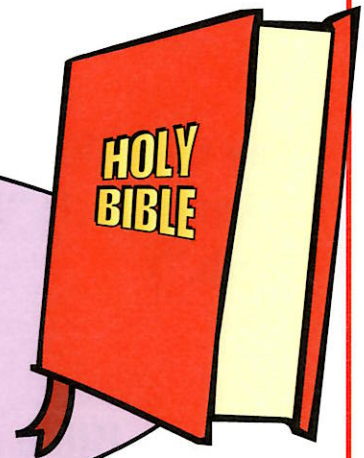
