Jesus' Miracles


Jesus did miracles so that everyone would believe He was really God's Son. He did all kinds of miracles for the people.

There was a pool at Bethesda. People thought an angel would come and stir up the water in the pool. People who couldn't walk or who were sick sat by the pool every day waiting for the water to stir. They thought the first one who could get into the water after it stirred would be healed. Jesus went by the pool one day and saw a lame man—one who couldn't walk—sitting by the pool. He had never been able to get into the pool when the water stirred. Jesus talked to him and told him to get up and walk. Right then, the man stood up and picked up his bed and walked!

What awesome power Jesus showed in His miracles!




