

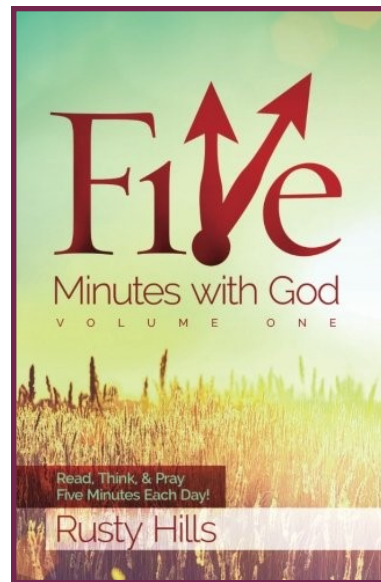
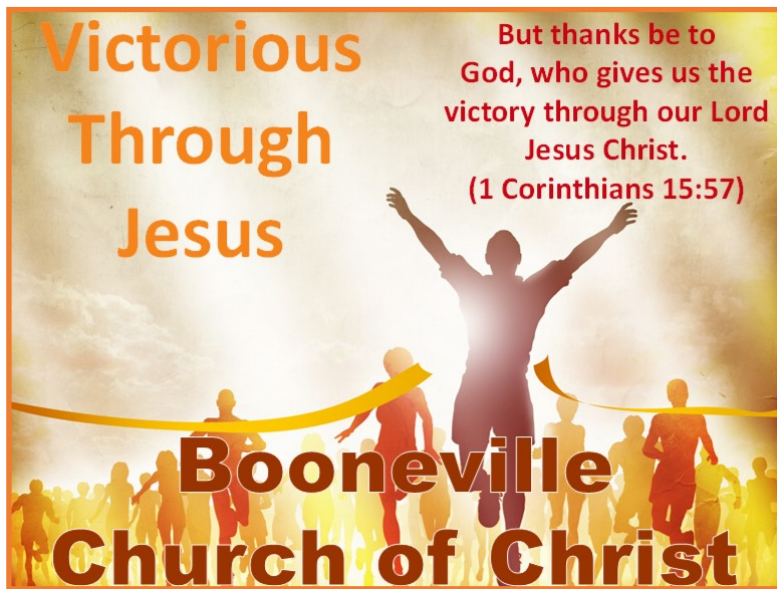
From the Preacher's Pen
