



Kings of Judah

Remember that Solomon's kingdom had been divided into two kingdoms—the kingdom of Israel and the kingdom of Judah. The people of the kingdom of Israel worshiped idols and were punished by God. Most of Judah's kings were also wicked. God was not happy with them either!


There was a good little prince in Judah. His name was Joash. From the time Joash was a baby, he had to be hidden from his wicked grandmother, Queen Athaliah. She wanted to rule the kingdom herself. She had killed all of Joash's brothers and sisters. What an evil grandmother Queen Athaliah was! She would have killed little Joash, too; but his aunt had kept him hidden in a safe place. Joash had a nurse who took good care of him. Joash needed to be hidden and protected so he could be king of Judah when the time was right.


