
Paul took a third preaching trip. When Paul went to Ephesus, he saw that most people there worshiped the false goddess Diana. There were many idols to Diana made out of silver. Demetrius had a silver business, and he made idols for people. Demetrius caused a riot, or a big fight, against Paul. Demetrius was afraid no one would want his silver idols any more if they believed in Jesus. After the riot was over, Paul left Ephesus and went to Greece.

Be ready to tell the class why there was a riot in Ephesus.

Wherever Paul and other Christians were, they worshiped just as we do. Every first day of the week, or Sunday, they took the Lord's Supper to remember Jesus' dying on the cross. They also sang songs, prayed, preached, studied Scriptures, and gave money. We do those things now.

Can you name the things Paul and the other Christians did when they worshiped God on the first day of the week?



At last, they all cried and hugged and kissed Paul goodbye. They were so sad because Paul had said that they might never see his face again.

On his way home, Paul met a prophet who told him he would be arrested when he got back home. Paul's friends were afraid for him, but Paul said he was ready to do anything for Jesus. Can we be ready to do anything for Jesus? Yes, with God's help, we can!


