



When We Do Something Wrong

David was a good man who loved and trusted God. But still, David sometimes did things that were wrong. David wrote several Psalms telling God how sorry he was for doing things that were wrong. As soon as David knew that he had sinned, he admitted it. Then he told God how sorry he was that he had done it. He asked God to forgive him for his sin.



We need to do exactly what David did. When we do something that is wrong, we must admit it. Then we must tell God how sorry we are and ask Him to forgive us. Sometimes we must tell other people we are sorry, too, and ask them to forgive us.

After we tell God we are sorry, we must try our best to never do those things again. It hurts God so much when we disobey Him.

But He will forgive us, just as He forgave David, if we tell Him we are sorry and really mean it.



When we do wrong things, what must we tell God?

When we tell God we are sorry for doing wrong things, what must we ask God to do?

Does God want us to try our best not to do those wrong things again?

David was sorry for doing things that were wrong. He knew how sad it makes God for one of His people to sin against Him. And when we sin, it is always a sin against God. But we can tell God how sorry we are. He knows just how sad we are and how hard we are trying.
