

Job and His Troubles

The book of Job tells us that Job was a good man. He loved God and tried to do everything God wanted him to do. Job had ten children. He also had a lot of land and animals—which made him very, very rich in those days. Everyone for many miles around knew about Job. Everyone knew how good he was.

Was Job a good man who loved and obeyed God?

Did Job have lots of children and land and animals?

One day, Satan asked God if he could test Job to see if Job really loved God. So God let Satan test Job. Satan killed all of Job's children and all of his animals. Satan made big painful sores all over Job's body. All Job had left were his wife and a few friends.




What terrible things did Satan do to Job?
